REINSTATEMENT ORDER

This matter comes before the court on the Petition for Reinstatement submitted by Drake Powell and received by this court on May 30, 2025. On April 4, 2025, the Supreme Court administratively suspended Mr. Powell for failure to timely register and pay the Guam Bar dues for 2025 despite having been duly notified by the Supreme Court of Guam of his delinquency and given time to comply with the delinquency notice pursuant to Rules 8(c) and 8(f) of the Guam Rules for Lawyer Disciplinary Enforcement and Disability Proceedings ("Rules").

Because Mr. Powell has since made a written request for reinstatement, submitted a current Guam bar registration, paid all arrears at the active annual rate plus all late fees and a penalty of 20 percent of the total amount due from the date of the last payment to the date of the request for reinstatement (payable to the Guam Bar), and paid the \$300.00 penalty (payable to the Supreme Court), he is now eligible for reinstatement. *See* Rules 8(d),(f). Therefore, the court **VACATES** the Suspension Order issued on April 4, 2024, and Drake Powell is hereby **REINSTATED** to the practice of law in Guam. His name shall be placed back on the roll of attorneys effective this date. Moving forward, Mr. Powell is cautioned to ensure compliance with his duties and responsibilities as a member of the Guam bar.
