**REINSTATEMENT ORDER**

This matter comes before the court on Peter N. Greenfeld's Request for Reinstatement to the Guam Bar Association, sent via email on March 15, 2024. On March 8, 2023, the Supreme Court administratively suspended Mr. Greenfeld for failure to timely register and pay the Guam Bar dues for 2023 despite having been duly notified by the Supreme Court of Guam of his delinquency and given time to comply with the delinquency notice pursuant to Rules 8(c) and 8(f) of the Guam Rules for Lawyer Disciplinary Enforcement and Disability Proceedings ("Rules"). On March 25, 2024, at the direction of the court, the Supreme Court Clerk of Court responded to Mr. Greenfeld's March 15, 2024, request, indicating that a reinstatement order from the court would issue upon satisfaction of the reinstatement requirements.

Because Mr. Greenfeld has made a written request for reinstatement and paid the arrears assessed upon him by the Supreme Court and the GBA Board of Governors, he is now eligible for reinstatement. *See* Rules 8(d),(f). Therefore, the court orders that the Suspension Order issued on March 8, 2023, is **VACATED**, and Peter N. Greenfeld is hereby **REINSTATED** to the practice of law in Guam. His name shall be placed back on the roll of attorneys effective this date.
