Under the authority to preside over attorney disciplinary actions through the Organic Act of Guam at 48 U.S.C.A. § 1424-1(a)(7), to issue orders in aid of our supervisory and original jurisdiction under 48 U.S.C.A. § 1424-1(a)(1), (3), and (4), and under Rule 10 of the Guam Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Enforcement and Disability Proceedings, with Respondent having been given notice and an opportunity to be heard, the Supreme Court of Guam issued its Order of Disbarment upon Respondent Stephanie Flores on August 13, 2024, the terms of which are incorporated herein.
