7 receipt by the Marshal, to the clerk of the court. When the execution is returned, the clerk must
8 attach it to the judgment roll.

Under the authority to preside over attorney disciplinary actions through the Organic Act of Guam at 48 U.S.C.A. § 1424-1(a)(7), to issue orders in aid of our supervisory and original jurisdiction under 48 U.S.C.A. § 1424-1(a)(1), (3), and (4), and under Rule 10 of the Guam Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Enforcement and Disability Proceedings, with Respondent having been given notice and an opportunity to be heard, the Supreme Court of Guam issued its Order of Disbarment upon Respondent Stephanie Flores on August 13, 2024, the terms of which are incorporated herein.

In accordance with that order, this **JUDGMENT** now issues to confirm the monetary obligation that the Superior Court is directed to collect, including but not limited to, through the issuance of a writ of execution under 7 GCA § 23103, Rule 69 of the Guam Rules of Civil Procedure, and all other applicable statutes and rules.

- Respondent Stephanie Flores's total obligation remaining under ADC10-005 and ADC12-002 is **\$105,638.00**. See Decl. Mardave Toledo (June 21, 2024) (incorporated herein).

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2. After payment of above obligations in restitution and related costs, Respondent Stephanie Flores shall pay to the Supreme Court of Guam the amount of **\$1,000.00** as a sanction for being found to be in contempt of court.
3. The Superior Court may apply any interest as required or authorized under Guam law.
